She was the Cofounder of the Canadian Academy of Audiology (CAA), a fellow of the American Academy of Audiology, a member of the American Academy of Dispensing Audiologist, a member of the Canadian Association of Speech Language Pathologists and Audiologists, and a former board member of the American Foundation of Audiology. Jean was an advocate for the profession of audiology. She was very passionate about helping others and making a difference.

The award recipient will be chosen based on who best conveys our message by a committee of Sounds+ representatives and will receive a \$1,000 scholarship.
